Classes:

You can choose from 1 of 2 classes at each event, FAST or FUN, here's the difference between the 2.

NOOB "FAST"

This is for those who want to compete and ideal for really honing in your driving skills against other racers.

- all FAST racers will be racing against each other

- they will run 3 qualifying runs, then be sorted into different mains
- all racers will be ranked and points awarded.

NOOB "FUN"

This is suitable for those who may be a bit apprehensive about joining a full fledge race or perfect for individuals of groups wanting to have a bit of racing fun without too much stress.

- join as an individual or with a group of friends
- all participants will be randomly grouped into groups of 6-8 (those who join as a group can opt to stay together in same group)
- race only within your group
- every group has their own winners
- 5-6 races for every participant

Now let's go through the basic rules.

RULES & STUFF...

Cars

2WD and 4WD 1/10 scale electric offroad buggies for respective classes.

Please contact us if you are in doubt if your buggy qualifies.

Electronics

Electronic Speed Controller: Any speed controller

Motor: Any 540-sized motor

Battery: Any battery pack not exceeding 7.4V is allowed

Electronic driving aids (such as gyroscopes or AVC): strictly forbidden.

Body shell: All cars must be covered with proper class-appropriate painted shell

Tires

The following tires are controlled in NOOB to reduce racing cost and maintain fair racing.

4WD: Front and Rear SWEEP SQUARE ARMOR (ORANGE COMPOUND) w GRAY

FOAMS

2WD: Rear SWEEP SQUARE ARMOR (ORANGE COMPOIND) w GRAY FOAMS

Tires are available for purchase at RaceWorks Hobbies.

Punctuality

All runs aim to start, run and end on time

All heats and mains will start on time even if any buggy is not there.

We aim to START each run at the specified time so your car should be on the grid before the starting time.

Sportsmanship

All racers should exercise good sportsmanship at all times.

No cursing or swearing at the event at all times.

Typical race etiquette should apply - e.g. allow race leaders to pass, etc. - that said, there are newcomers who might be unaware of these, feel free to educate in a friendly and courteous manner.

Acts demonstrating a lack of Sportsmanship will be awarded race penalties.

Marshaling Duties

All drivers are required to perform marshal duties according to the race schedule. In the case that drivers are unable to perform marshal duties, a representative is allowed. In case of drivers not performing marshal duties, penalties will be issued. Marshaling points will be set up; drivers/assistant will have to proceed to the respective marshaling point base on their car number.

Pit Tables and Charging

All participants are required to bring a towel or cloth to cover the pit table. All batteries to be charged in proper battery charging bags. All participants are reminded to take best care of the pit equipment provided and are liable to cover the cost of any damage due to abuse.

"Stop n Go" Penalty

"Stop n Go" penalty will be awarded to drivers for un-sporting behavior with the decision from the race director and his assistant.

Technical Inspection

All racers are expected to follow the race rules. Organizers will conduct random technical inspections and reserve the right to do so at any time for any car. Cars that fail inspections will be issued penalties or disqualified based on inspectors' discretion. All inspection results will be final and no appeals will be entertained.

Race Results

All race results will be final with after all cars completed inspection. Appeal to race results will have to be made immediately after the race result is published and before the start of the next run. Appeals made after the next run start will be entertained on a case by case basis on the decision by race director / organizer.

Personal Transponder

Organizers run an AMB Lap Counting System compatible with both AMB square type Transponders and Personal Transponders.

Drivers are requested to prepare their own personal transponder.

Limited rental transponders are available and will and allocation priority will be given to racers who don't own a transponder on a first-come-first-serve basis.

In the event of transponder miss count or failure, Race Director / Organizer will make the final decision

Other Rules

Any other race rules or info will be provided by the Race Director on race day itself. When in doubt, please see Race Director. All decisions by Race Director are final.
